

3501 **GENERAL NOTES**

- 1. Manner of Wear. The Alternate Uniform is authorized for officers, midshipman, instructors, and auxiliarist as a distinctive uniform for those members who are unable to wear the military style officer's uniform due to weight standards, medical condition, or other contributing factor. The NSCC Alternate Uniform is not civilian attire but identifies the wearer as a member of the Naval Sea Cadet Corps.
- 2. <u>Procurement</u>. All items listed are civilian in nature and can be procured commercially or from the sole-source provider contracted by National Headquarters.
- 3. <u>Uniformity</u>. Uniformity is paramount. Personnel will wear the appropriate uniform for the occasion. It is unprofessional to wear working uniforms to ceremonies, parades, public appearances, or when Cadets are in dress uniforms.
- 4. <u>Safety and Comfort</u>. Uniforms prescribed for wear should be selected when all issues in regards to member safety and comfort have been reviewed and considered.






